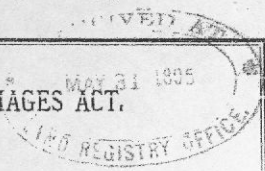

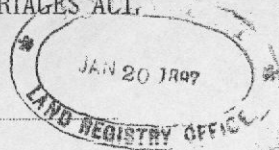

OLD-TIME RESIDENT DIES

Late Thomas Luscombe Had Lived in
Victoria for Past Twenty
Years.

Thomas Luscombe, a resident of the city for the past twenty years, passed away at his home, 1527 Amelia Street, yesterday morning at the age of seventy-seven years.

The late Mr. Luscombe was a native of Yatton, England, and came to Canada nearly sixty years ago. Prior to coming to Victoria he had spent twenty-three years in Montreal and thirteen years in Toronto.

He was a veteran of the Fenian Raid and a member of the St. George Lodge, A. F. & A. M., of Montreal, and the Queen City Council of Royal Templars, of Toronto.

He leaves to mourn his loss, besides his widow, three sons and four daughters: William, of San Francisco, Cal.; V. T., of this city; Thomas G., of Iditarod, Alaska; Mrs. B. Hemmings, of Montreal; Miss Ann C. Luscombe, Mrs. C. R. Graham and Miss Grace Luscombe, all of this city.
