Built in 1854 to accomodate thirty children under fifteen years of age in the Craigflower area (then called Maple Point), Craigflower School is the oldest school building now standing in Western Canada. Charles Clark was installed as the first teacher at a salary of one hundred and fifty pounds a year, and for a time church services were also held here by the Reverend Cridge. This clap board school house, with its high pitched wooden roof, is now in use as a museum.
