## DEATH OF PETER STEELE.

---

Pioneer Saloon Keeper Dies at His Residence, Craigflower Road.

---

Peter Steele, proprietor of Steele's saloon on Bastion street, died last night at his residence on Craigflower road. The deceased had been ailing for some time and his demise has been expected for some days. Peter Steele came to Victoria in 1863, and engaged in the saloon business, in which he continued until the time of his death. His saloons were always popular resorts with the business men of the city, and in his present premises he accumulated quite a fortune, which he invested in realty in the city. He came to Victoria from Montreal, near which city he was born. A widow and one son survive him.

The deceased was deservedly popular among the old-timers of the city, none of whom when in need, had to ask twice from him for assistance. The charitable institutions of the city were also frequently benefited by his charity. The funeral arrangements have not yet been announced.

Funeral on Sunday.—The funeral of the late Peter Steele, whose death was announced in these columns yesterday, will take place on Sunday afternoon at 2:30 from his late residence, Craigflower road, and at 3 o'clock from Masonic Hall, Douglas street. Besides the members of the Masonic lodges the Pioneers will attend the funeral. The deceased was 57 years of age, a much younger man than he appeared. He came to Victoria when he was but 17 years of age, and remained continuously, unlike most of the Argonauts, failing to take the gold fever, although he spent one season in the early sixties keeping a store on the Skeena river. It was in the late sixties that he went into business in the premises on Bastion Square, where he continued until the time of his death. In the early days he and Mr. H. W. Shepherd, city jailer, were cabin mates, and their friendship continued until the last.

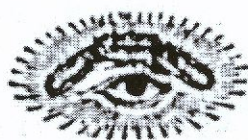
