Notes:

Lettie Ann Cherry was listed as the owner of lots 161 and 162. These assessment numbers are for a building on lot 161. Her name appears in the assessments in 1893, and continues through to 1900 when John Cherry's name appears. Lettie Ann Cherry still owned lot 162, but no improvements appear in the assessments through to 1901 (that's as far as I got). Is it possible that 1020 and 1014 are on the same lot? Is it also possible that 1014 is the small house that was first built for Lettie Ann Cherry in 1892? The assessment amount that is listed in the Vic West book chapter (Page 316) I have is the same that is listed in the chart above.

1902 is when things got a little crazy in lots 161 and 162. The assessments for 1902 and 1903 were combined, but these numbers had a 1902 date stamp beside them:

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Harry Creech

Those homeowners and business people who had purchased lots in Cumberland townsite now felt the need to establish a municipal authority independent of the colliery company. They applied to the provincial government, and on **1st January 1898**, the **Municipality of the City of Cumberland** was officially incorporated.

This house and two others in the same block of Derwent, between Second and Third (2741, 2745 Derwent), are studied as representatives of the twelve remaining rental cottages built for merchant **Harry Hamburger**. He purchased all of Block 12 from UCC in 1894 and subdivided each of the 60-foot-wide lots. He likely only built on 18 of the 24 half-lots; various reports in the *Weekly News* between 23 May 1894 and 5 March 1895 mention construction of at least 17. Property tax assessments tell us that the ones on Allen were built first, and the *Weekly News* tells us that **James Carthew (2706 Maryport)** was the contractor for at least one of them.

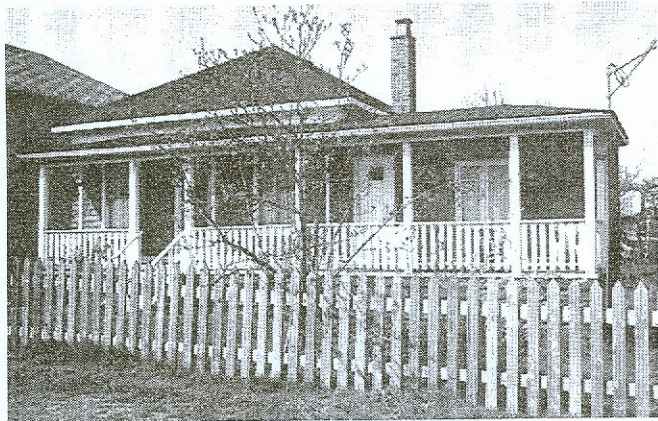
Because Hamburger was Jewish and the block was distinctive for its singularity of building style, it became known as **Jerusalem**. By WWI this name referred to all the old residential area south of Dunsmuir Avenue.

Harry came to Union in 1893 and for three years managed the *Union Store* or the *Big Store* for **Simon Leiser (2706 Dunsmuir)**. (Harry's brother, **Moses Hamburger**, was Leiser's partner in his Wellington store and his son-in-law.) In mid-1896, Harry opened his own shop selling groceries, dry goods, boots and shoes in the 1893 *Cumberland Store* building (2687 Dunsmuir) vacated by **McKims (2714 Maryport)**.

Within a year he sold the business to **Gustav "Gus" Hauck (2706 Dunsmuir)** and left for the Klondike gold rush. In August 1898, the *Weekly News* announced that he had made \$100,000 at Dawson. Unfortunately, like many others who went to seek their fortune in the Yukon, we don't know what happened to Harry after that.

The house was rented for a number of years: tenants in 1901, according to Canada Census, were miner **John Kelsey** and his wife **Mary**. The second owners were **William and**

Jenny Braes. William was a carpenter and city alderman in 1918. In 1931 during the *Great Depression*, he was an organiser and spokesman for unemployed in Courtenay.

Next owners were **Harry and Caroline (Mellado)** *also an Creech*. Harry was a traveller and an automobile enthusiast. He organized the *Cumberland-Courtenay Automobile Association* in 1913 and was elected its first president. *apdholsterer*

Caroline was the daughter of **Bruno Mellado**, a Spanish Chilean who was the colliery's master carpenter, and **Mary Ann Thompson**, whose father **John Thompson**, one of Vancouver Island's first miners, came from Scotland in 1850 along with **Robert Dunsmuir**. Bruno and Mary eloped in August 1871, and were issued the first marriage licence in the newly-established province of British Columbia. *for Walker Bono in Victoria 1884-1888 then Chemist Creech 1889-90*

The property was owned for several years by prominent Victoria law firm **Eberts and Taylor**, which occasionally did business in Cumberland. **Honourable David McEwen Eberts** was a Member of Provincial Parliament (MPP, as early BC legislators were called), Attorney-General, Speaker of the House, and finally Justice of the Supreme Court of British Columbia.

From 1918-32, the house was owned by **Andrew and Caroline Bogo (2743 Windermere)**.

Angelo Antonio and Leonatti Eugenia "Genia" Bono then owned it until 1975. Angelo, a miner, came from Castellamonte, Torino, Italy in 1910. He was a nephew of **Peter Bono (2697 Penrith)**, one of Union's earliest pioneers. Genia came in 1920 to work as housekeeper in the *Waverley* for **Domenica Dallos (3273 First)**, and married Angelo, whom she had known in the old country, a short time later.

The Bonos had three boys, **Reno Antonio "Porky" (2577 Dunsmuir)**, **Frederick** and **Edward**, and a girl, **Clelia**, who was scalded to death at the age of two. Angelo was a member of UMWA, Cavalotti Lodge and frequented the *Waverley*. He retired from mining in 1955 and died in 1972. Genia died in 1988, aged 90.

The original portion of this **Frontier-type bungalow** has a ridged, hipped roof with a full-width, hipped-roof front verandah. The original front facade is symmetrical, the central door flanked by sash windows (in this case, two-over-two). The house has recently acquired a large, sympathetically-designed side addition, which imitates and extends the verandah to twice its original width. The colour scheme is traditional: rust-stained cedar-shingle siding (over the original drop siding) and white-painted wood trim. The detailing on the porch posts and balustrade has been simplified over the years. The picket fence is almost identical with that in an historical photograph of 2745 Derwent.
