Roy Cherry, aged 14 accidentally shot by playmate, Robert Spouse, aged 11... precarious condition... much sympathy with his parents, the more so as it was only last Xmas that they lost another son, who was drowned while on a hunting trip near Esquimalt Harbour. Sep 27 - An inquest into circumstances surrounding the death of Roy Cherry, son of Mr/Mrs John W W Cherry, who died Sep 25 as the result of a 22-calibre rifle bullet, in the hands of his playmate, in the latter's home on Viewfield Street.
The lads, while playing about the place, found the rifle, and young Spouse in pointing the weapon towards Cherry discharged it, the bullet piercing the latter's breast near the heart. The rifle had been loaded the night previous by an elder brother of young Spouse, who thought he had heard someone trying to get into the house. He forgot to remove the cartridge in the morning. Deceased leaves a mother and father, 2 sisters and a brother to mourn his loss. native of Victoria, British Columbia. Born Jun 18, 1915 at Cherry Bank, Church hill, Victoria, British Columbia, wife of H Currie, son. [Colonist, 1915-06-19*]

Died Aug 4, 1916 at Victoria, British Columbia, William James Roper, a pioneer of Upper Country. native of Sherborne, Dorsetshire, England, b 1840, educated there, subsequently accepting an office in Royal E India Co service. This he left when the gold rush commenced in the Cariboo, and he made his way to this coast around the Horn, in company with a large number of people who became Resident of Victoria. He landed here in 1862. He did not linger long in Victoria, however, but continued on his way to the Interior, where the gold discoveries were attracting such wide attention. He set out from Ft Yale to Cariboo in a mule pack train, with 8 mules abreast. After many years spent in Cariboo mining community, he decided to go into stock raising, and, with a 150# pack on his back, he walked 100's of miles in search of a suitable location. He eventually cast his lot at Cherry Creek, Thompson Valley, before the Canadian Pacific Railroad, and continued to acquire land and stock until he became known as 'The Cattle King', and the largest private rancher in British Columbia. He carried on cattle-raising to such an extent that at one time he possessed lands, either leased or freehold, extending over 40 or 50,000 ac, with 5 or 6,000 head of cattle grazing on it. The main headquarters were situated at Cherry Creek, on S side of Thompson, c 13 Michigan W of Kamloops, while others were at Mappercombe, near Tranquille. Before the Thompson River was crossed by bridges, he often had to ford the water on horseback.... Aug 6, 7 - Pallbearers: Hon D M Eberts, Dr O M

Died suddenly May 11, 1897 at Esquimalt, BC, Frederick Thomas Ashley, 41, native of Strand of the Green, Kew, England. Pallbearers, member of Sons of Saint George: Messrs Potts, Oldershaw, Munn, Cook, Greasley, Gough. [Colonist, 1897-05-13*]

Died Sep 27, 1909 at East Sooke, British Columbia, Alexander Dawson Donaldson, aged 70. Deceased was Native of Stirlingshire, Scotland, and came to Victoria, British Columbia, in 1864, making his way across the plains of the continent by ox team. He is survived by a widow, 2 sons and 1 daughter. Mr Donaldson was one of the pioneers of British Columbia prospectors and was a goldseeker of the old school, being both mine seeker and assayer. He was the original locator of the Nootka marble quarries at Nootka Sound, now being worked, of the Howe Sound mines, and other British Columbia mines, and few prospectors knew the coastline better from Victoria to Skagway than did Mr Donaldson. He made prospecting trips, so many that he lost count of them, and returning with his float and samples he did his own assaying, and could talk with a thoroughness that few could on the riches of the various sections of the coast. After many years of prospecting he settled down to farm life at Sooke about 10 years ago, where he lived with his family.

He came as a young man to the United States from Scotland, spending some years in Wis. He traveled across the United States in the pre-RR days with an ox-wagon and had many adventures for the days when he migrated to Wis were ready to attack travelers, and when the buffalo herds ran over the prairies. After spending his younger days in Wis he came to British Columbia in 1864 with the numbered lured here by the news of the Fraser River and northern gold finds and from the time he reached the province until 10 years ago he was engaged in gold mining.
