## School withdraws

Glenlyon School withdrew its application for expansion from the Tuesday afternoon agenda of Oak Bay council's land use committee.

According to headmaster Chris Gordon the application was removed "at this time" as it needed further study, while Glenlyon's chairman of the board Scott Gardiner said it was withdrawn "because of developments that require further discussion."

Neither one though was willing to expand upon their

remarks.

Glenlyon, an independent school located along the waterfront on Beach Drive, had made application to council last month for an expansion into Grades 11 and 12 and to expand its campus onto property it owns on the west side of Beach Drive, across from the present location of the school that presently educates boys in Grades 1 through 10. \*\*
