Henry C. Hall was a barrister in the firm of Tait, Brandon and Hall with offices in the B. C. Permanent Loan Building. He became Queen's counsel in 1952 and later a magistrate. Judge Hall retired in 1959 and died in 1962.

He was a successful barrister when this home was built in 1913 for \$4,500. C. Elwood Watkins designed the home in a solid Edwardian tudor revival style with a verandah facing what would have been a nice ocean view. The siting beside Bowker Creek would have added to the rural charms of the residence.
