2744 Avebury Avenue

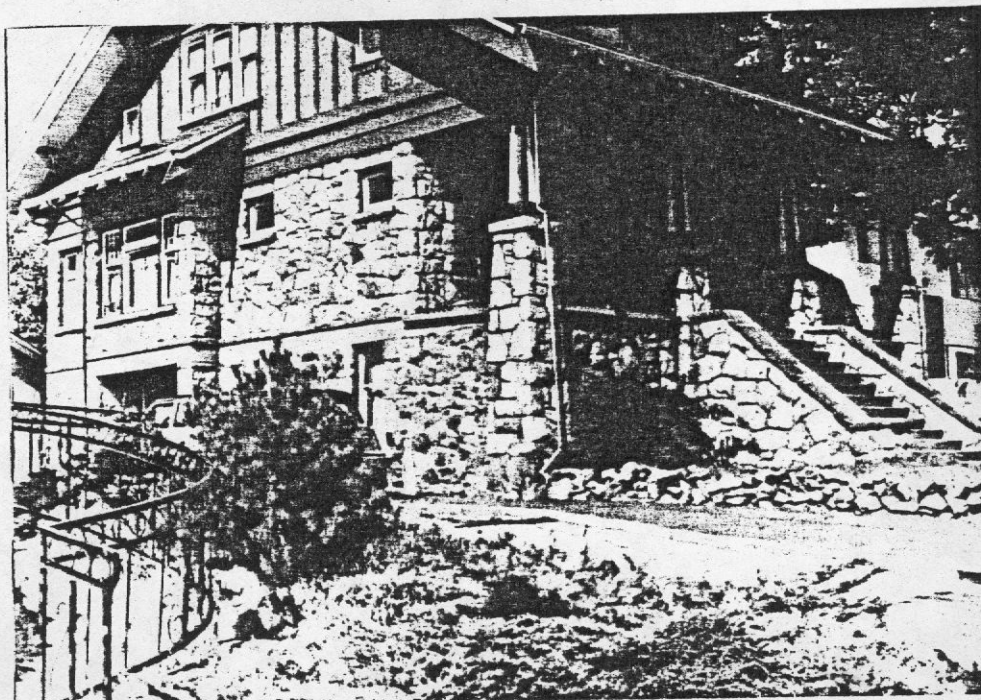
According to a card left by Jody Hunt:

"2744 Avebury Avenue was built for Mr. John V. Johnson in 1914. Building Permit Number 6494 was issued to Mr. Johnson on March 27, 1914 for an eight-room, one and a half storey frame dwelling to be built at an estimated cost of \$4000.

Mr. Johnson, who is listed as a carpenter in the 1914 city directory, was the son of Oliver Johnson (see 1439 Pembroke Street) and brother of Byron Johnson, former Premier of British Columbia.

There are no building plans for the house in City Hall."
