



Top picture shows the gold rush prison and police headquarters that once adorned Bastion street. Puzzled about the building on the extreme right? It's on the East side of Government Street. View Street didn't cut through from Broad to Government till 1910.

It was in the late '80's (with the building of the Hillside jail on Topaz Avenue) that the old Bastion Street prison was demolished and a new court house built on the site. Today it's the Maritime Museum, shown in the bottom picture.
