The Board of Trade building in Bastion Square, constructed in 1892 by the British Columbia Board of Trade, is a significant landmark in this historic precinct. Designed by Architect, Maxwell Muir, the red brick facade is a rich mixture of Hich Victorian and Richardsonian Romanesque stylistic elements. The owner of the building is applying for heritage designation in order to qualify for the Building Incentive Program of the Victoria Civic Heritage Trust.


