Pursuant to the provision of By-law No. 242, of the City of Victoria, application is hereby made to the City Engineer of the said City for permission to construct sewers on the above mentioned premises in accordance with the accompanying plans and these particulars, and to connect the said sewers with the public sewer in Avalon Road street. The undersigned hereby agreeing to cause the work to be done in accordance with the aforesaid By-law, and the standard specification provided for in said By-law, the material to be furnished in accordance therewith, and such modifications as may be required by the City Engineer, and further, that all work herein contemplated will be executed in a workmanlike manner.

No modification of the plan and these particulars, or of the work described therein, will be made unless the same is previously allowed by the City Engineer, and all work pertaining to the proper plumbing and sewerage of the buildings and premises which is not covered by the plan and these particulars, but is found necessary during the progress of the work in order to carry into effect the true intent of the By-law and standard specification, shall be executed in accordance with the directions of the said City Engineer aforesaid.

NOTE.—Earthenware sewers are shown on the plan in red lines, and metal pipes in blue lines.

Report and Recommendation of Inspector.

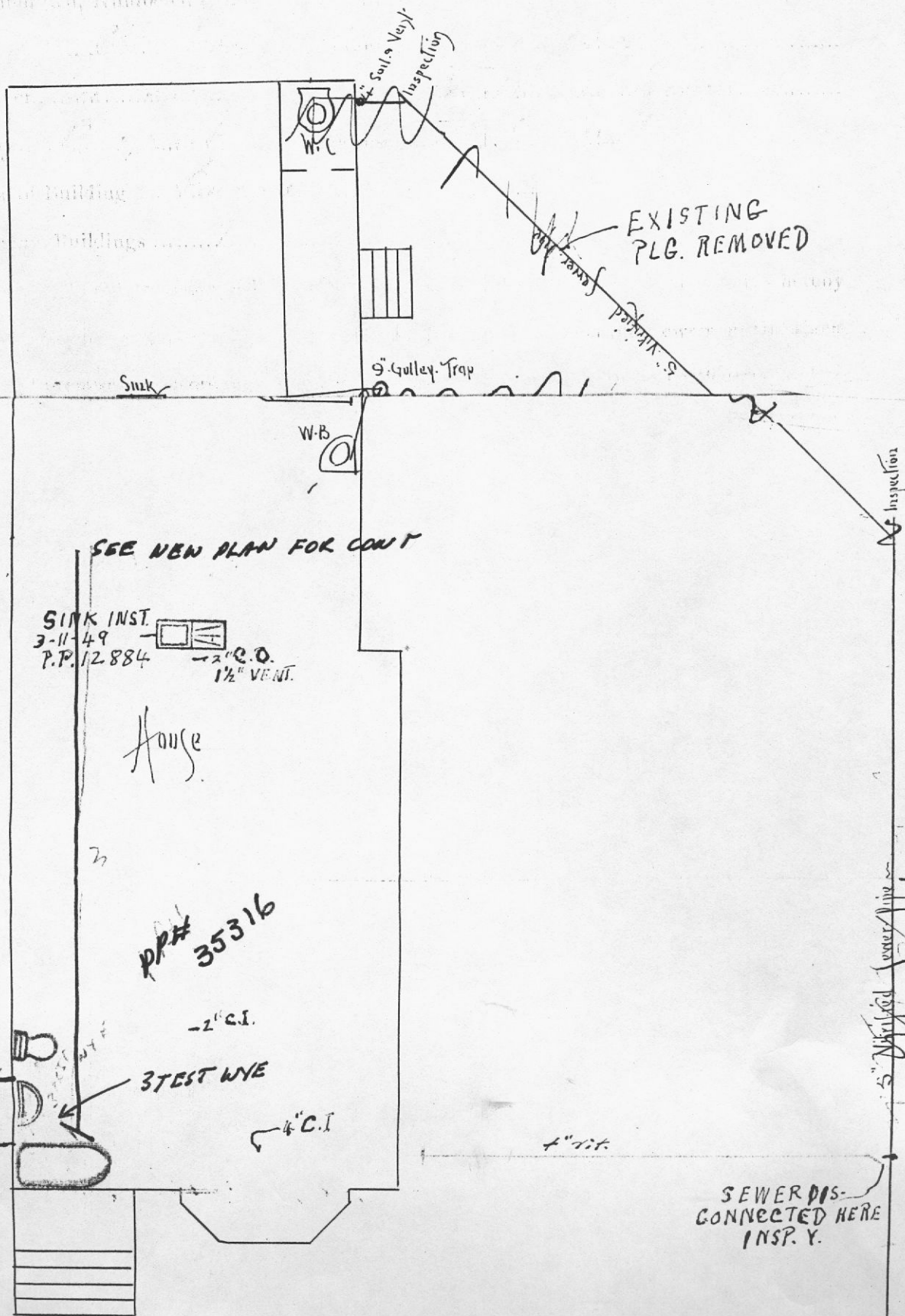
