This residence, built in the Craftsman style, was constructed by Mr. Lacoursiere, a well-known local builder. The house, which has a basically rectangular plan with two bays, features a wrap-around open porch. The building is clad in a number of finishes, typical to the Craftsman ideal. The upper storeys are stuccoed and half-timbered in the English manner.

OKLAWAHA was built by Kenneth Streatfield, who owned the property to the South and East, where he operated a fruit-growing business. His daughter Betty Bell's book THIS FAIR LAND describes the area in Edwardian times.
