## 96 ATKINS ROAD

This tidy cottage at the corner of Atkins and Chilco Roads was built in 1935 and remodelled in 1976. Much of the original appearance has been retained narrow clapboard siding and overhanging eaves suit the 1930's bungalow style. Origins of the building are unknown, however, the proximity of the now defunct C.N. Railway Line is a possible historical link. The rail embankment is right in the "backyard" at this address - the house may have served a station or bunk facility. The C.N.R. line was active during the 1930's, serving a timber-transport function between this area and Youbou, B.C.
