The Mellor Building, designed by C. Elwood Watkins, went up in 1912, just to the east of the Royal Theatre, and was listed as a "new building" in the 1913 city directory. George Mellor of Mellor Brothers, purveyors of paints, oils, wallpaper etc. was the owner, and one of the first companies in the building was the Dominion Automobile Association, with employees Benjamin S. Cannon, Keith W. Macrae and William W. Stephens.

Mellor Apartments appeared in the city directory in 1921 and they were there until 1980, when the building was acquired and restored by CFAX Radio. Mellor Apartments began as seven units, then became eight units in 1929 increasing again to nine in 1941. All the apartments were on the upper

floor, with various businesses at ground level.

In 1919 the Mellor Brothers retail business was listed at 819 Broughton and this is the first appearance of this street number in the directories. Presumably the business occupied the ground floor with the apartments above. At this time there were various businesses and people occupying 825 Broughton. Mellor Brothers stayed at 819 Broughton for many years but then moved to 1028 Blanshard, after which the company appears to have gone out of business. 819 Broughton became Gibson's Studio Photography in 1952 and this business stayed there until the change of ownership in the late 1970s. After the 1980 restoration the building seems to have been re-numbered with 819 no longer being used. Broughton Communications were at 823, along with Monday Publications, Trade Typesetting and Real Estate Victoria. CFAX Radio was at 825 Broughton by 1984 with the remainder of the building as offices for B.C. government departments. Later occupants were a firm of lawyers and a mortgage company.

CFAX Radio moved out early in 2008 and the building is now owned by the Nature Conservancy of Canada.

# Collapsed While Cranking Car FICATE OF REGISTRATION OF DEATH on Highway Saturday Night; Well Known Here

Collapsing while cranking his car on the Pacific Highway near Langford on Saturday night, Frederick Mellor, well-known sign painter of this city, was hurried into St. Joseph's Hospital by passers-by and passed away at the institution yesterday. Mr. Mellor had never had a day's illness in his life and his death came as a great shock to members of his family and a very wide circle of friends.

Born in Manchester, England, in 1877, the late Mr. Mellor came to Victoria in 1893, residing here ever since. He entered the sign-painting business, having an office at 577 Yates. Street. For many years he had been active worker in the Liberal Association.

He is survived by his widow and two daughters, at the family residence, 1178 Oxford Street; two brothers, George of Mellor Bros., painters and decorators, and Frank Mellor, a Provincial civil servant; also three sisters. Mrs. A. Hammond and Mrs. L. Vickers of Victoria, and Mrs. H. Harwood of Reval, Russia.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Wednesday from the B.C. Funeral Chapel. Interment will be made in Ross Bay Cemetery.
